LEVEL I GROUP CLASSES

Level I group classes are ideal for beginning students. A weekly class that runs for ten weeks, they provide an affordable introduction to the instrument in a collaborative setting, allowing students to focus and learn basic techniques before transitioning to Level II classes and private lessons.
